Subject: GUSTAV Status/Actions Message 002

#### Status

- 1) Hurricane GUSTAV track in accordance with computer model consensus shows GUSTAV now turning more easterly.
- 2) Impact to North Texas primarily heavy rain and gusty wind conditions beginning Wednesday
- 4) Section Readiness Condition remains at Level 4 - Awareness

#### Actions

- 1) Continue to keep all ECs, AECs and OES appointees informed
- 2) Monitor 7285 KHz LSB in the daytime and 3873 KHz LSB in the evening for activation of the TEXAS ARES Net. These frequencies will be used for Emergency Operations only. H&W traffic will be handled on 7290 KHz LSB in the daytime and 3935 KHz LSB in the evening
- 3) Several Red Cross shelters have reported evacuees arriving and either being sheltered at the initial point of arrival or being moved to other shelters
- 4) Continue to respond to requests to support EOC operations and Red Cross Shelter management

Thank you for the reports of activity to date. Continue to provide them as time allows.

I anticipate leaving the Section Condition Level at 4 for the time being.
